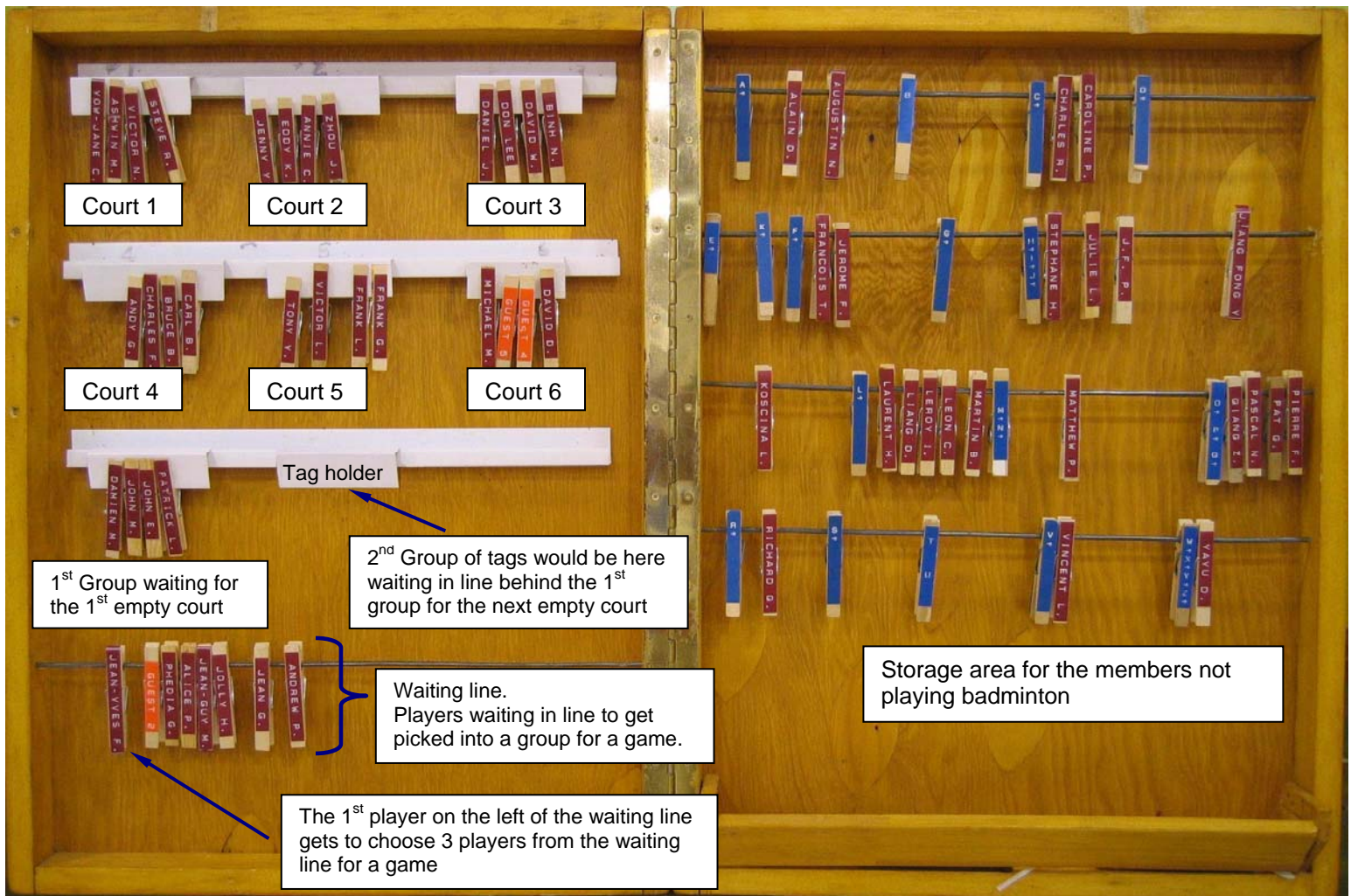


The NDG Badminton Club Board

How Does It Work



1. When the player wants to play badminton, he or she must get their tag from the storage area and put it on the waiting line. After he or she is finished playing badminton for the night, the tag must be returned to the storage area in alphabetical order. This rule does not apply to a guest.
2. There will be a guest tag provided for the guest. The guest must pay first in order to obtain the guest tag. At the end of the night, the guest tag must be returned to the club.
3. The first player on the left of the waiting line gets to choose any 3 players to the right to make up a foursome group. These four tags would then be put on a tag holder and then be allocated to be the 1st group waiting for the next empty court. If there is a group already waiting, then this group would be allocated as the 2nd group waiting or third if the 2nd position is also occupied.
4. When a court is empty, for example, the 1st group of tags waiting would move to the empty court. The 2nd group of tags waiting, would become the 1st group waiting.
5. The tags coming off the court after the game would return the tags to the waiting line.
6. Birds for the game would be located in front of the board. The group would take the bird for the game and return it to the board after the game.
